Research Results Released on Cold Tolerance, Water Use & Other Key Golf Indicators for Oklahoma State University's Tahoma 31® Bermudagrass

Orlando, FL (January 27, 2020): Tahoma 31, the latest bermudagrass variety developed by the turfgrass researchers at Oklahoma State University, and making it's Golf Industry Show debut this year in Booth #1207, recently released a compendium of <u>research results</u> that show the grasses' cold tolerance, low water use, and other key indicators important for golf courses, when compared to other commercially available bermudagrasses.

Among the research results highlighted are:

- **Cold tolerance:** Test results from Purdue University through the National Turfgrass Evaluation Program (NTEP) showed Tahoma 31 had the highest rates of winter survivability with only 4% winterkill in conditions that decimated many of the bermudagrass cultivars tested.
- Low water use: In Oklahoma State University tests that measured evapotranspiration rates under non-limiting soil moisture conditions in Oklahoma (Amgain et al., 2018), Tahoma 31 fared best, and used 18% less water than TifTuf.
- Traffic tolerance: Testing locations in 16 states (NTEP) ranked Tahoma 31 in the top spot for early spring green-up among all vegetative bermudagrass cultivars tested.
